


- Rijeka, Split, Dubrovnik, Varaždin (Uni Zg)

Duration and goals



- *Duration:* 12 months (15.10.2006 14.10.2007.)
- *Wider Objective:* Fulfilling the Bologna requirements and demands of The Act on Higher Education and Research in Croatia in order to join EHEA. Preparation of Croatian Higher Education bodies and institutions for the entrance of Croatia into European Union.
- Specific Objective: To promote the Bologna goals, especially a cycle system (including postgraduate study), connection of higher education with research and development, diploma recognition, Qualification Framework and quality assurance to employers, professionals, academics, students and the whole community in Croatia and to raise the awareness of social cultural and economic aspects of Bologna reform
