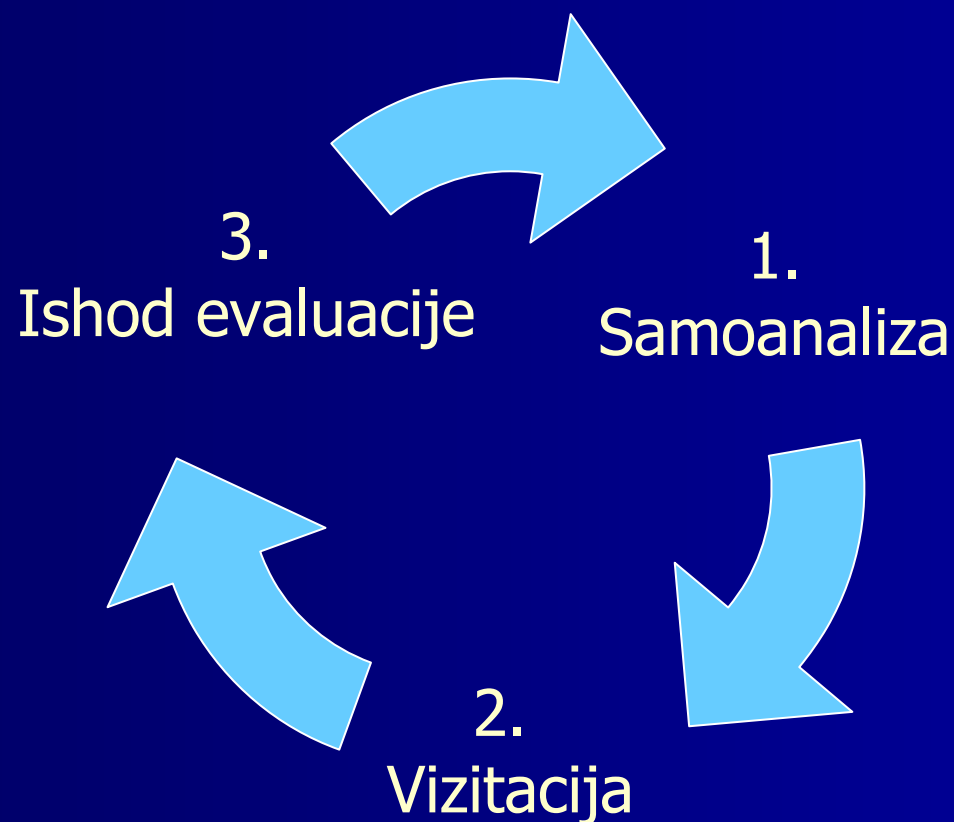

- to manage the **European System of Evaluation of Veterinary Training** based on the mandate given by the Commission of the European Community

JEC = Joint Education Committee

In 2000: the common education committee of EAEVE and FVE took over the role in reviewing the evaluation reports
Provided by the evaluation teams.



Evaluation

98 member establishments
EAEVE

51 evaluated → 37 approved

approved = the establishment fulfills the minimum compulsory requirements for all EU Member States (Directives 78/1026 and 78/1027/EEC and new Directive 2005/36/EC))



Balanced and Coordinated

The distribution of the theoretical and practical training among the various groups of subjects shall be balanced and coordinated in such a way that the knowledge and experience may be acquired in a manner which will enable veterinary surgeons to perform all their duties.



The Evaluation System

Standard Operating Procedures (2002)

The main stages are:

- Preparation of a self-evaluation report by the vet institution
- Visit to the institution by a group of experts
- Preparation of a report on the visit by the group of experts
- Review of the experts' report
- Decision by the Joint Education Committee

Future: a Two Stage Approach

The new evaluation system:

First stage: evaluation if the faculty conforms to the Directive 2005/36/EEC

Second stage: certification/accreditation

Full transparency of the results of the evaluation system



Certification / Accreditation

Second stage:

Control of the quality management system of the faculty

CONTINUOUS ENHANCEMENT

The faculty shall prove to have

- relevant methods for quality control of training, assessment and learning opportunities
- a sustainable system for quality assurance
- a plan for quality enhancement
